


Who was St. George?

A great deal of information on St. George is available on the internet, but in summary:

St. George is the Patron Saint of England, venerated as one of the 14 Auxiliary Saints, or Holy Helpers, and is understood to have been an early Christian martyr. There is no actual evidence of George's life or deeds, but tradition holds that he was a Roman soldier and was tortured and decapitated under Diocletian's persecution of Christians in 303, AD. The legend of George's "slaying of the dragon" persists, is linked to the ideals of chivalry, and is often depicted artistically as a knight in armour adorned by a scarlet cross.

About the Order of St. George

The Order of St. George traces its roots to the Fraternal Society of Knighthood of St. George which was founded by King Károly Róbert of Hungary, and which is believed to be the most ancient of the chivalric orders, or confraternal orders, that were created as royal institutions independent of the Church. While the precise date of its foundation is not known, the Society is believed to have been in existence on April 23rd, St. George's Day, in 1326. Historians suggest that although the Society had a political role, it also functioned as an institutional embodiment of the ideals of chivalry within the court of the King. Since that time, the Order has persisted primarily in Europe for almost 700 years and is known for its charitable works and its links to the selflessness of military service.

The Order in Canada

On March 1st, 2003, The Grand Priory of Canada and the Americas was consecrated at Christ Church in Niagara Falls, Ontario by our Founder, Chevalier Gareth Green, a Knight in the United Kingdom Order of St. George. On that date, 16 Postulants were invested as the first Knights and Dames of the Niagara Priory, with Chevalier Green appointed as our first Grand Prior.

By 2005, The Order had grown to encompass a second Priory in Toronto. Eventually, the membership decided to expand the purpose of The Order beyond its original establishment as a recognition order to become a working order, and to raise funds for good works. In line with its evolving purpose, The Order sought incorporation in January 2007 and the incorporation of its charitable arm, The St. George Foundation, in January 2013.

From its original complement of 16 members in the Niagara Priory, The Order has developed considerably both in membership and in organization. As of July 1, 2024, there are some 400 Knights and Dames in eight Priories spanning most of Canada under the leadership of the Grand Prior.

Our Chivalric Code

In a modern context, Chivalry is expressed in the deliberate pursuit of a positive and proactive lifestyle of integrity, honour, courage, loyalty, compassion, self-discipline, courtesy and service. The ideals of Chivalry are represented in the symbols and pageantry of The Order, and in The Vows of Knighthood reaffirmed at each Investiture.

This Code sets out the values, ethics, and expectations to which we commit as Knights and Dames of our Order. The vows of knighthood are those of the 14th Century Knight which are:

"A Knight is sworn to valour, his heart knows only virtue, his blade defends the helpless, his might upholds the weak, his word speaks only truth."

Once invested, every Knight and Dame takes up our common purpose to serve the aims of The Order and, in the words of the Oath taken at Investiture and reaffirmed at subsequent Investitures,

"To continually practice the Chivalric virtues of Faith, Service, and Honour."

Members of the Order of St. George undertake to demonstrate by word and deed their commitment to the values, ethics and expectations set out in this Code.

FAITH, SERVICE & HONOUR

We value the chivalric virtues of Faith as it resonates personally, Service as it pertains to helping others, and Honour as striving to do what is right in word and deed.

MISSION & PURPOSE

The Order of St. George is a Chivalric Order whose Mission is: To better the health and well-being of members of the Canadian Armed Forces, Veterans and their families, and to support the Cadet and Junior Canadian Rangers Programs.
