The CSIS National Memorial Cemetery

A memorial to those who served courageously in the shadows

The CSIS National Memorial Cemetery is an outward appreciation of the service of the CSIS and its current and former employees.

The CSIS National Memorial Cemetery was created by the tri-partnership between CSIS, the Pillar Society and Beechwood Cemetery Foundation. Over the course of the next few years, the CSIS National Memorial Cemetery will be building a memorial monument that will honour all current and former CSIS employees. CSIS NMC will have significant enhancements including flagpoles, pathways and beautiful landscaping.

The CSIS National Memorial Cemetery will be a place of national commemoration for current and former CSIS employees and all Canadians.

The men and women of CSIS, like their predecessors in the RCMP Security Service, have served Canada, the Canadian people and Canadian interests overseas, since the mid 1940's. They have gone about their work quietly, without public recognition and expecting none. The men and women of CSIS and the Pillar Society now have a final, dignified resting place, hallowed ground where family, friends and other Canadians may pay their respects, within the shadow of the Peace Tower. They are honoured to rest in the company of the Canadian Forces, RCMP and Ottawa Police Service.



For they have all dedicated their lives to Canada and the Canadian people and have contributed greatly to making Canada the wonderful country that it is.

The CSIS National Memorial Cemetery , to our knowledge, is the only Western intelligence service that has a dedicated national memorial cemetery dedicated to its employees.

*Care and Maintenance Fund Contribution

Land:

As required under the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 and Ontario Regulation 30/11, the amounts below will be contributed to an irrevocable trust fund known as the Care and Maintenance Fund. Income (interest) from this fund is used to cover care and maintenance expenses of the cemetery in perpetuity.

For one in-ground grave, 2.23m ² /24ft ² or larger	40% (or minimum \$290)
For one child or cremation grave, smaller than 2.23m ² /24ft ²	40% (or minimum \$175)
For one columbarium niche	15% (or minimum \$165)
For one mausoleum crypt	20% (or minimum \$830)

The Bereavement Authority of Ontario Fee is charged by the BAO in order to provide its services of information on your options in bereavement services and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed. Should you have any questions, please visit thebao.ca

Care and Maintenance Fund Contribution - Memorials:

As required under the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002, the following amounts must be paid to the cemetery operator before a marker is installed. After each marker installation, the amount will be contributed to an irrevocable trust fund known as the Care and Maintenance Fund. Interest from the fund will be used to cover expenses for the care and maintenance of markers and monuments in perpetuity.

For flat markers measuring less than 1,116.13cm ² / 173in ²	\$0
For flat markers measuring 1,116.13cm ² / 173in ² or larger	\$100
For upright monuments 1.22m / 4ft or less in height and 1.22m / 4ft or less in length, including base	\$200
For upright monuments more than 1.22m / 4ft in height and 1.22m / 4ft, including base	\$400

Payment, Financing and Funding

For services at time of death:

Payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 1 %, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, e-transfer, MasterCard and Visa. Payment plans are available through a third-party credit union. Financing charges apply to payment plans.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services and supplies that are being arranged pre-need, before a death has taken place, you may pay for the services and supplies at today's price. Pre-paid funds for services will be placed in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made by cash, cheque or credit.

Guarantee: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.

Additional information about payment, financing and funding options is available upon request.

TRADITIONS

This example includes : up to four hours of visitation in a visitation suite on the day prior to the service. The next day includes one hour of visitation in the visitation suite followed, by the Funeral Service in the Sacred Space and final disposition. (Casket present)

Your interest in the CSIS National Memorial Cemetery

Dear Member;

Thank you for your interest in the CSIS National Memorial Cemetery, at Beechwood Cemetery.

There are many single and two grave locations available and all locations are extra depth allowing 2 traditional casket burial per grave. We also allow up to 8 urns per grave to be interred in all traditional graves.

All traditional locations will allow for a single upright family monument. A single sized monument will generally hold up to 2-3 names and a two grave monument as many as 6-8 as the additional 8 inches of width allows us to accommodate more information on one line.

All monuments must have the CSIS crest to the top of the monument and can accommodate other crests as long as they are not larger than the CSIS crest.

We have a number of cremation lots with each location accommodating 4 urns per lot. This location will use an angled Pillow style monument in black granite with room for the CSIS crest and 2 names.

The Beechwood Cemetery will retain \$300 from every land/niche sale within the section and this will go toward the central monument.

To show our commitment to the community, we are offering:

- 10% discount on land and niche purchases.
- 10 % discount on funeral services, if pre-arrangemenged before a death has taken place

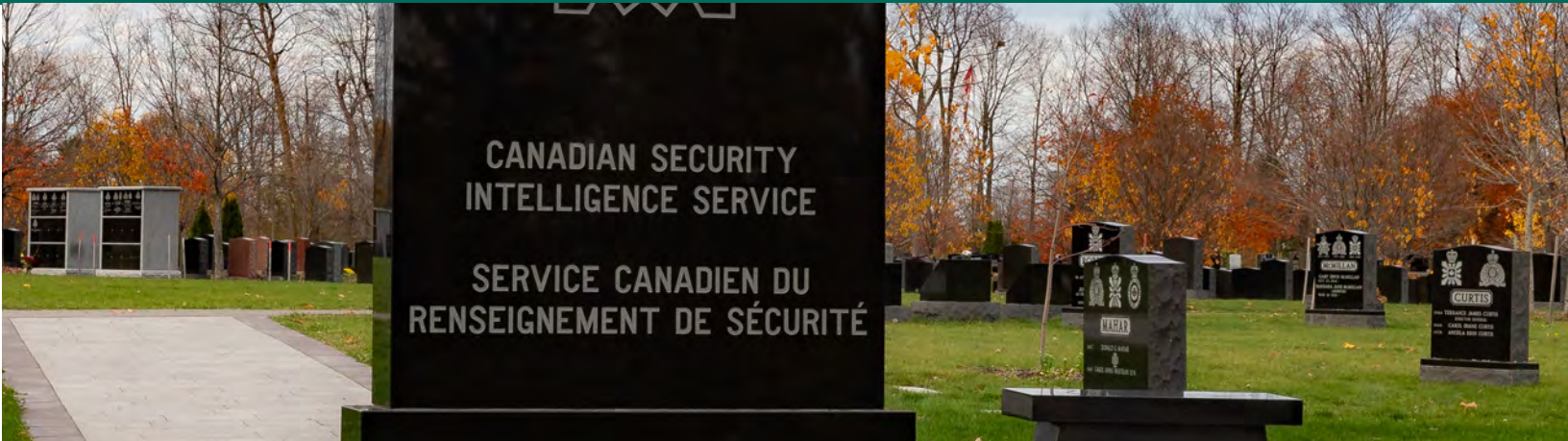
Our rates will be reviewed and updated on an annual basis beginning April 1of each year but families will still enjoy discounts off Beechwood's regular rates.

All of the monuments do not need paint as the contrast is vibrant enough to see clearly from a distance. All monument costs above are averages based on having 3 polished surfaces (front, back and top) and will vary due to colour, carving and finishes.

Note: Larger monuments are done on a quotation basis.

HST is applicable to all costs associated above. All pricing is not retroactive and cannot be applied to previous purchases. All group rates increase annually beginning the 1st day of January unless otherwise posted.

Payment Policies for Funeral and Cemetery Services:

Frontline Financial Credit Union has partnered with Beechwood Funeral, Cemetery and Cremation Services to provide loans to our families for the purposes of paying funeral and/or cemetery expenses. Beechwood offers flexible financing and payment options to meet individual needs.

Conditions/Features:

- Loans are available from 1 to 15 years
- Loans are fully open and can be paid off any time without penalty
- Credit Union membership required - \$75 membershares
- Application fee of \$75 waived
- Must be less than 69 years of age to qualify for life insurance
- Pre-existing conditions - 6 months prior and 6 months after
- If joint life insurance coverage is purchased, the loan will be paid in full on the death of either applicant
- Life insurance coverage ends at age 76
- Life insurance premiums are not age banded and are reimbursed on a prorated basis if loan is paid out early
- Payments based on interest rate of 7.99%*, 5 year renewable term
- On approved credit, some conditions may apply
